Youth member exception: When traveling to an area, regional, or national Boy Scout activity or any Sea Scouting event under the leadership of an adult (at least 21 years of age) tour leader, a youth member at least 16 years of age may be a driver, subject to the following conditions:

- a. Six months' driving experience as a licensed driver (time on a learner's permit or equivalent is not to be counted)
- b. No record of accidents or moving violations
- c. Parental permission granted to the leader, driver, and riders
